
About Us

Having deployed our missionaries to the various unreached communities, we have witnessed God's power and greatness both spiritually and socially.

Social Impact~ Donation

In collaboration with various organisations, churches, individuals and agencies, donations were made of various items including:

- **Educational Support:** In Tinsung, students received vital educational materials, including books, pens, pencils, and erasers, to aid their learning and academic growth.
- **Food Relief:** The community of Menji was blessed with food supplies, helping to alleviate hunger and improve well-being.
- **Clothing Donations:** Clothing items were donated and distributed to individuals in need across several communities.
- **Devotionals:** "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it." Devotional materials were shared to inspire and guide young people.
- **School Uniform Distribution:** Children without school uniforms in Nansoni, Tuasa, and Tuna were given new uniforms.
- **Sanitary Products for Teen Girls:** Teenage girls in Tinsung and Busa were provided with sanitary products, promoting personal hygiene.
- **Jesus Film Movement:** To support the screening of the Jesus Film in Busa, a projector and a mini speaker were provided, enhancing access to the Gospel.
- **Audio Bibles Non-readers:** In the Yagaba community, audio Bibles were distributed to individuals who are unable to read. This initiative ensures that the message of the Gospel reaches everyone, regardless of literacy level.

SOCIAL IMPACT

1. Readers and Writers Club

This is a club that helps develop the reading and writing skills of children in various communities. These clubs are run in 5 of the Operation Serve communities.

2. Youth Mentoring

The youth are the architects of tomorrow, hence there is a lot of intentionality in engaging these young people in the various communities we serve.

3. Sports Ministry

In a number of our communities, sports is a tool that is used to convey the message of the Gospel while relishing the excitement thereof.

4. Educational Durbar

Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today. Educational durbars were held in three communities: Nansoni, Yagaba and Togo.

5. Special Classes for JHS 3 students

"Excellence is not a skill, it's an attitude" -Ralph Marston. For the success of the final year students, special classes were provided.

6. Cadet Teams were initiated in Yagaba.

7. Tree planting exercise at Tuna.

8. Witches Camp Programs



4. Senior High School students









Spiritual Transformation

- **Church ministration:** The missionary has been called to the whole community, including the church. Whilst on the field, missionaries regularly minister to already existing churches in the community, including the International Central Gospel Church, Church of Pentecost, Assemblies of God Church and the Anglican Church, just to mention a few.
- **Church planting:** Seven churches were planted in various communities that had no church by our missionaries.
- **Church revival:** Revival begins with God's own people. Churches that were dormant by God's grace, through the presence of missionaries, were revived.

Outreaches

Our outreaches in the communities were done in different ways, taking into consideration the background of the community with other characteristics.

- **House-to-house ministrations:** The Church was sent to the homes of families in the communities.
- **Jesus film movements:** The Word of God had its expression in movies and became a powerful tool for communicating to the people.
- **Sports outreaches:** For the love of sports by many children, we reach out to them with the Gospel.
- **School outreaches:** Moments of worship at schools have always been life-transforming.
- **Farm ministrations:** The Gospel must go everywhere, including the farms. Farm ministration at Busa.
- **Crusades:** "If Jesus Christ be God and died for me, then no sacrifice can be too great for me to make for Him." - C.T. Studd. Crusades were held at Tuna.



Evangelism

Souls won: Altogether in various communities, over 550 souls were won through various outreaches. won

Discovery Bible Groups: “Jesus said, feed my sheep”. For new converts to grow in the Lord, Discovery bible groups were established. Seventeen of these groups were established in various communities.

Discipleship making movements: “Jesus commands us to make disciples of all nations”. Discipleship-making movements were strengthened in Sierra Leone, having more young people becoming intentional with discipleship.

Holy Spirit & Water Baptism: *It is the man who is born of water and the Spirit that can enter the kingdom of God (John 3:5).* Converts were made received both water baptism and the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Ministries

Children Ministry: *Jesus said, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.”(Matthew 19:14). And so we allowed the little children to come!*

AWANA: *Indoors and outdoors games were done to get the children with the Gospel.*

Bible stories and Storytelling: *Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 11:19*

Disciples: *Many of these children were raised as disciples.*

Men and Women ministry: *Other ministries for men and women were also initiated and strengthened In Cote D’Ivoire.*




